



Code of Ethics for Research and Publications

Version 1.0

Chitkara University broadly follows the guidelines released by UGC (University Grants Commission), IEEE (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers) and COPE (Committee on Publication Ethics) as a standard benchmark to ensure that researchers engage themselves only in ethical research.

A gist of such guidelines is presented as below -

1. Researchers at Chitkara University will

- conduct their research activities with full responsibility while keeping the interest of the country and organization at top priority.
- never fabricate / manipulate any data being obtained from any kind of experimental/theoretical research
- be transparent in indicating their conflict of interest in case of accepting to the task of reviewing the research papers
- always make sure that they follow the due guidelines issued by UGC related to similarity index and plagiarism in their articles.
- ensure that the research articles / thesis / reports being communicated would not have more than 10 % similarity index.
- target to publish their research work in high quality journals only
- stay away from predatory journals as notified by UGC from time to time
- follow all the guidelines issued by various Institutional Ethics committees
- acknowledge sponsoring agencies like DST, DBT, MEITY or FICCI who fund their research efforts

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- think through carefully for the sequence of authorship in their research papers and will not have any conflict regarding Intellectual Property rights
- wisely use the power of social media to spread the message about their research
- duly acknowledge the work of other researchers in case they use any part of the same in their publications under creative common license.
- Try to conduct collaborative research only with those researchers /laboratories which follow ethical guidelines

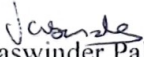
2. Researchers at Chitkara University are well verse of
